Black Pod "causes global yield loss of 20-30% and tree deaths of 10% annually."



Chocolate Class

Cocoa is the fourth largest agricultural driver of forest loss globally

All analyzed commodities explain 57 percent of tree cover loss from agriculture; cattle alone explains 36 percent Forest area replaced by analyzed commodities


Comprehensive view of cocoa plots within the direct supply chain for driving collective action and contributing to transparent monitoring
